GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR ADMISSION

A candidate can take CORE COURSE in subject not studied in Class XII if he / she has studied the related subject in Class XII.

CORE COURSE in	Related Subjects in class XII
Education	If the candidate has not studied Education as a subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political science/History/Statistics/Physics/Chemistry / Biology be treated as related subjects.
Sociology	Candidates passed the previous qualifying examination (10+2) in Science/Humanities/Arts (except commerce) stream with any subject will be allowed to get admission in sociology (CORE COURSE)
History	Students from science, commerce stream and students who have not studied History in (10+2) can apply.
Political Science	Students from science, commerce stream and students who have not studied the subject in 10+2 can apply.
BFAD	Students who have passed in 10+2 exam with 45% aggregate in Case of General candidate & 40% aggregate in case of SC.ST Candidate.

CRITERIA TO ISSUE ONLINE ADMISSION FORM IN CORE COURSE

Candidate need to fulfill the following conditions to get Admission Form in the above mentioned subjects (Except B.FAD).

- 1) O.B.C-A & O.B.C- B to be included in admission form.
- 2) Cut of marks according to C.U. criteria for CORE COURSE.
 - a) A minimum of 50% in aggregate and 45% in the subject or related subject. Related subject for Education CORE COURSE is Psychology, Philosophy, Mathematics, Sociology, Economics, Political Science and History. Candidate from Science and Commerce stream or any subject from Arts can select History and Political Science as CORE COURSE. OR
 - b) 55% marks in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying exam. OR
 - c) 50% in the aggregate when the candidate has not to studied the subject in his/ her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.
 - d) Minimum 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying examination for SC, ST, PH, OBC-A & OBC-B candidates (Certificate must be given for verification).
- 3) COLLEGE CRITERIA for Journalism and Mass Communication 60% in English or Bengali (1st language) and minimum 40% in aggregate.
For CMEV (Major) Minimum of 55% in English and 40% in aggregate.
B.FAD candidate must pass H.S. or equivalent in 10+2 exam with 45% aggregate in case of General candidate & 40% aggregate in case of SC, ST candidate.
- 4) Bengali or English will be the answering medium for all examinations under C.U.
