





In view of the evolving situation on the spread of Novel Corona virus (COVID - 19), the advisories issued by WHO, UN and Central Government and as a matter of abundant precaution to check its spread in the State of West Bengal, it has been decided that all Government, Government-aided, private educational institutions - Schools, Colleges, Universities, Madrasahs, SSK/MSK will remain closed from 16 March, 2020 to 31 March, 2020 in public interest. The internal examinations of these institutions will also remain suspended during the said duration.

**Suspension of classes, examinations of the University of Calcutta and its affiliated colleges from 16 March 2020 to 31 March 2020 to combat spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19)**

Based on advisories by WHO, UN and Central Government, and the Press Release issued by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, West Bengal, and as per notification No.86/1(3)-SSE/20 dated 14.03.2020 of the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, all classes, examinations of UG & PG courses of the University of Calcutta and its affiliated colleges, academic departments of the University will remain suspended from 16 March 2020 to 31 March 2020 as a precautionary measure to check the spread of COVID-19.
